

# Important Reminder for all CMA CANDIDATES

## Examinee conduct and cheating on the CMA exam

### CHEATING

Examinees who are caught cheating during the exam will have their grades invalidated and will be expelled from the CMA® (Certified Management Accountant) program.

Cheating includes:

- copying answers
- using unauthorized materials
- helping another candidate during the exam
- removing exam materials from the testing room
- disclosing exam questions to others
- falsifying credentials

### SHARING QUESTIONS

Sharing CMA multiple-choice and essay exam questions with others after taking the exam is a violation of ICMA's examinee conduct policy and is considered cheating.

### COPYRIGHT VIOLATION

A CMA candidate who reproduces, reuses, or distributes CMA materials without prior authorization from the publisher is subject to legal action as well as expulsion from the CMA program.
